PUBLIC NOTICE

UPDATES TO TAXPRO MAX

In line with FIRS' commitment to further simplify tax compliance and promote ease of doing business in Nigeria, taxable persons, tax practitioners and the general public are hereby notified as follows:

- 1. The automated tax administration system (TaxPro MAX) has been updated in order to resolve the challenges hitherto encountered by taxpayers in generating payment reference number (PRN) and paying tax liability in piecemeal. As such:
 - 1.1 persons possessing valid login credentials on the TaxPro MAX are now able to generate PRNs remotely without having to visit FIRS' offices;
 - 1.2 TaxPro MAX is enabled to allow taxpayers defray any tax liability in whole or in part; and
 - 1.3 additional tax assessed by way of desk review, tax audit or tax investigation (including penalty and interest) may be settled in lump sum or in piecemeal.

Please take notice that all outstanding tax liabilities shall continue to attract interest as provided by the law until fully discharged.

- 2. Taxpayers who have outstanding tax liabilities, are required to immediately start payment and ensure that all such liabilities are fully defrayed not later than 30th November 2023, after which the Service shall commence enforcement activities (in accordance with tax laws) to recover all unpaid taxes.
- 3. The Service is closing all desk reviews, tax audit and investigation exercises that have lingered beyond the allotted time. Therefore, all taxpayers having open cases are to provide all outstanding information not later than 30th November 2023, failing which the Service shall close those cases based on information available to it.
